GET TO A SAFE PLACE

Make safety your number one priority. If possible, turn on hazard lights to alert oncoming drivers and move yourself and loved ones to a safe location.

CALL 911

Call 911 for immediate emergency medical assistance. Ensure the 911 operator knows the location, injuries, and number of vehicles involved.

ASSESS INJURIES

Check yourself and others for injuries. Even if you feel the injuries are not severe, seeking medical attention is crucial. Some injuries may not be evident immediately, and a medical examination will need to be conducted.

DOCUMENT THE DETAILS

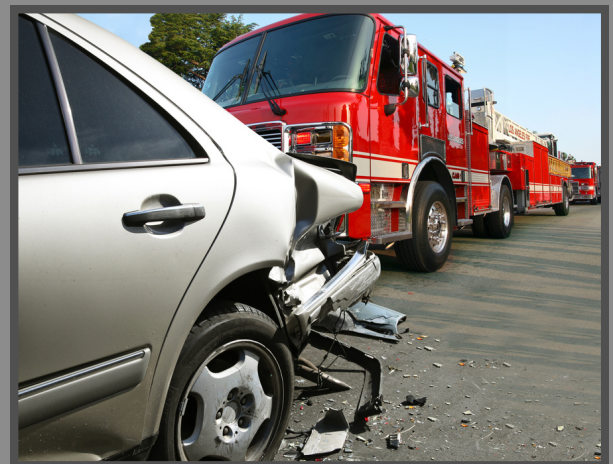
If conditions allow, document the scene with your smartphone. Leveraging photos and videos can be a powerful tool for future reference.
